2. Section C, Youth Rider Classification

Change youth classes names back to following:

1.) Micro 4-8, 0-51cc 2 stroke or 4 stroke automatic (with max wheel diameter of 10 inches)

2.) Macro 4-8, 0-51cc 2-stroke Premix chain, 80cc 4stroke. DS 80, PW 80, XR 80 (not all inclusive)

3.) Peewee 7-11, 52-66cc 2-stroke; 9-11 PW 80, DS 80, 80cc 4-stroke; (not all inclusive)

4.) Premier 7-15, 7-11 restricted to mini bike, 67-86cc 2-strokes. Big wheel 85/112, up to 150cc 4-stroke. must be 12 to 15 years old. (not all inclusive)

3. Section C, Youth Rider Classification

Combine Youth Sportsman 50 and Youth Sportsman Mini classes to form one youth beginner class to run with the 50cc classes. Max of 14" front wheel.

- 2.) 65cc 7-11, 0-65cc 2-stroke; 9-11 PW 80, DS 80, 80cc 4-stroke; (not all inclusive)
