Definition of classes and Riders:

This is only meant to be a guide, please see the ARMCA www.armca.org rule book for specific definitions for each discipline.

Competition: We have 6 disciplines in our competition division, they are normally divided into Youth and amateur levels. Amateur competition usually consists of A, B and C classes and normally has ages 12 years old and up (not all inclusive).

Youth: A youth rider is intended to be a beginner or experienced and range from 4 years of age up to 17 depending on the specific class and discipline of racing. A, B and C classes are not considered youth classes. A youth rider may ride in designated A, B, or C class if their age and size of machine is allowed in class.

Family Trail Rider: A family trail rider is for Trail riding ONLY. This will include parent and a maximum of 3 other dependents.

Associate: This is a member that does not ride or compete but wants to support ARMCA through a membership.

Road Rider: This is for points paying road riding events.

Trail Rider: An off-road trail ride includes any type of terrain, all of which can be covered by a single-track vehicle. This is not a speed-oriented event.

Minor: Someone that is under the age of 18. For a minor to compete or ride during an event an annual release from the AMA is highly recommended. If an annual release is not present at signup then both parents/legal guardians must be present to sign the release waver. If both parents/legal guardians have not signed the release the minor <u>cannot participate</u> during the event. Any minor participating in an event must be accompanied by an adult.
